The fund aims to achieve the highest sustainable income payout that is possible without eroding the fund's inflation adjusted capital base. The fund aims to grow this income and the underlying capital of the fund in line with inflation (CPIX). The fund is actively managed and is able to invest in high yielding equities, bonds, fixed deposits, money market instruments, listed debentures, property collective investments, listed property equities and other high yielding securities.
